PARKING

It is recommended that participants park and enter the Mall of America on the East Side. If your group is planning to arrive via bus, please email maureen.gruys@somn.org for instructions.

CHECK-IN

Check-in is open from 12:30 - 7:30 PM

Participants are required to check-in at Sears Court (East side, first floor) to turn in any day of money, and pick up their wristband, food ticket and any swag they earned! You can check in as a team or as an individual.

Reminder: all participants are required to fundraise a minimum of \$50 in order to participate. Participants can bring cash, checks or pay via credit card the day of the event. Checks should be made out to SOMN or Special Olympics Minnesota.

If a participant requires a PCA / Guardian during the event, they will also need to check in at Sears Court to receive a wristband. Parents, guardians and PCA's who do not need to be in the main dancing area can watch from the sidelines.

WHAT TO BRING

Not much! Your participation in UDM comes with snacks and water throughout the day, so you won't need to bring any food with you. It might be nice to carry your cell phone and some extra cash (just in case!)—and, of course, your dancin' shoes! No backpacks or bags will be permitted. Be sure everything fits in a fanny pack, which you can buy onsite!

FOOD

As a participant at UDM, you will receive a food ticket upon check-in. This will allow you to redeem food throughout the day from our food partners. NOTE: food will not be brought into the Rotunda this year, and participants will be leaving the space to get food throughout the day.

Food allergies: Gluten-free options for food include the Chipotle chips and guacamole, as well as the custard from Shake Shack. No substitutions/replacements are available for the pizza, pretzel or cookie.

PARENT / GUARDIAN / PCA VIEWING AREAS

If a participant requires a PCA / Guardian during the event, they will also need to check in at Sears Court to receive a wristband. Parents, guardians and PCA's who do not need to be in the main dancing area can watch from the sidelines (outside of the barricades on Level 1) or from Level 2 overlooking the Rotunda.

WHEELCHAIR ACCESS

Participant wheelchairs and other support needs are allowed into the Rotunda, but are subject to searches from Mall of America Security.

PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded hourly, and are available only to participants who are currently in the Rotunda. Announcements will be made for upcoming prizes so participants can plan accordingly.
